Discussion Items

The team discussed 2 items at this meeting. They were:

Guard Rails and Timeframe for Recertification

Guardrails

The team decided that this portion of the program should essentially mirror the current CSAO program with the addition of more information related to the scaffold type guardrail systems as they are the most common in industry. The point was made that, although wooden guardrails are less common, they are still in use primarily on Commercial and Institutional Construction Sites and should be included.

This section of the training should show examples of each of the styles of guardrail.

Timeframe for Certification

The team unanimously agreed that 3 years was an appropriate timeframe for recertification once a person had taken the new standardized program.

For discussion at our next meeting:

Additional Discussion

As a follow-up to the discussion around cranes and the difficulty in meeting the 1.8 M requirements, Lonnie indicated that Mammoet has begun adding engineered tie points to their equipment and Sterling is deciding which way to go, but will probably do the same.

6. Pass/fail considerations for testing.
7. Inclusion of addendum to standard template highlighting “substantial” changes.
8. What other programs besides CSAO, IEC will be recognized?
