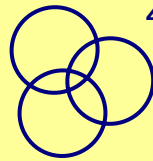

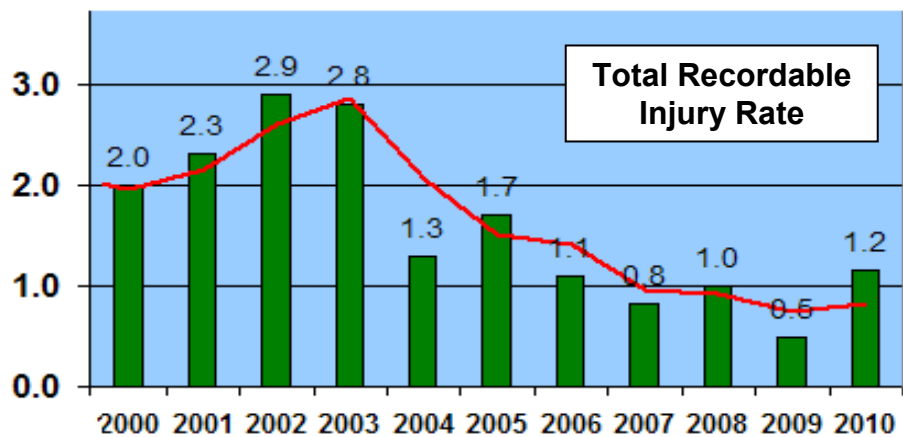

Preventing and controlling workplace violence does not have to be difficult or complex.

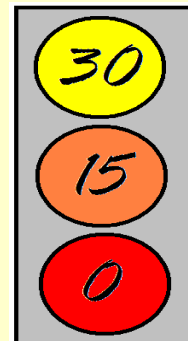
