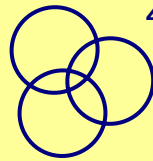

FALL PROTECTION: The Boilermakers (Local 128) and the Labourers (Local 1089) are now accredited training organizations for the new Safety Partnership Fall Protection course. Congratulations to Blair Allin and Victor Horvath in achieving accreditation for themselves and their organizations. The date for compliance to this new Fall Protection standard is August 1st, 2011.

**FALL PROTECTION
RECERTIFICATION:** Fall Protection recertification classes have been piloted since December 2010 and will receive final STS approval on March 3rd, 2011

WATCH:** This course will be piloted at 7:30AM Feb 28, 2011 here at the IEC.

PAY @ CHECK-IN UPDATE

The IEC Pay @ Check-In Committee has temporarily postponed further work on the concept of companies and individual workers paying for classes prior to checking in at the IEC.
