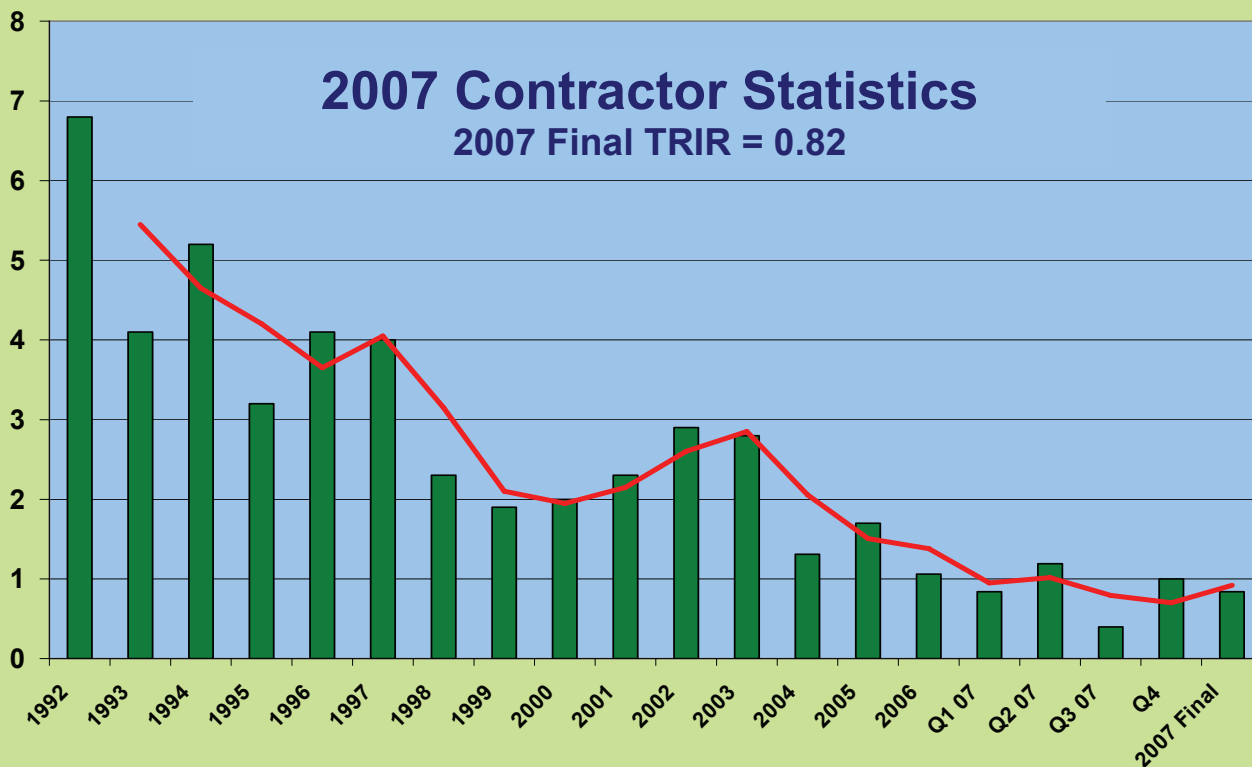

## The Story behind the Numbers

Contractor recordable injury statistics have shown a steady decline to a new low of 0.82 per 200,000 worker-hours. Worth noting is our 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter TRIR which stood at 0.4. This is the lowest recordable injury rate for any quarter since we have been keeping track and was accomplished in a year of high contractor hours.
