SAFETY ATTENDANT AWARENESS TRAINING PROGRAM: Mobile Equipment/Supplied Air/Hot Work

COURSE OUTLINE

The job of Safety Attendant for Mobile Equipment, Supplied Air, or Hot Work is a key function in keeping workers safe on the job. This 1.5 hour program covers the following content:

- Mobile Equipment Safety Attendant Requirements
- Mobile Equipment Communications
- Supplied Air Safety Attendant Requirements
- Supplied Air Operations
- Hot Work Safety Attendant Requirements

Special focus is placed on the challenges of a Safety Attendant role which include remaining focussed and alert. The authority and responsibility to suspend work when a condition/behaviour/action makes it unsafe for workers is emphasized.

Through question and answer, discussion, and scenarios, the following learning objectives are achieved:

- Discuss/recognize/appreciate the requirements for a:
 - Mobile equipment attendant...including communications, PPE, training
 - Supplied air attendant...including pressure gauges and regulators
 - Hot work attendant...including pre-job duties and controls for spark containment
